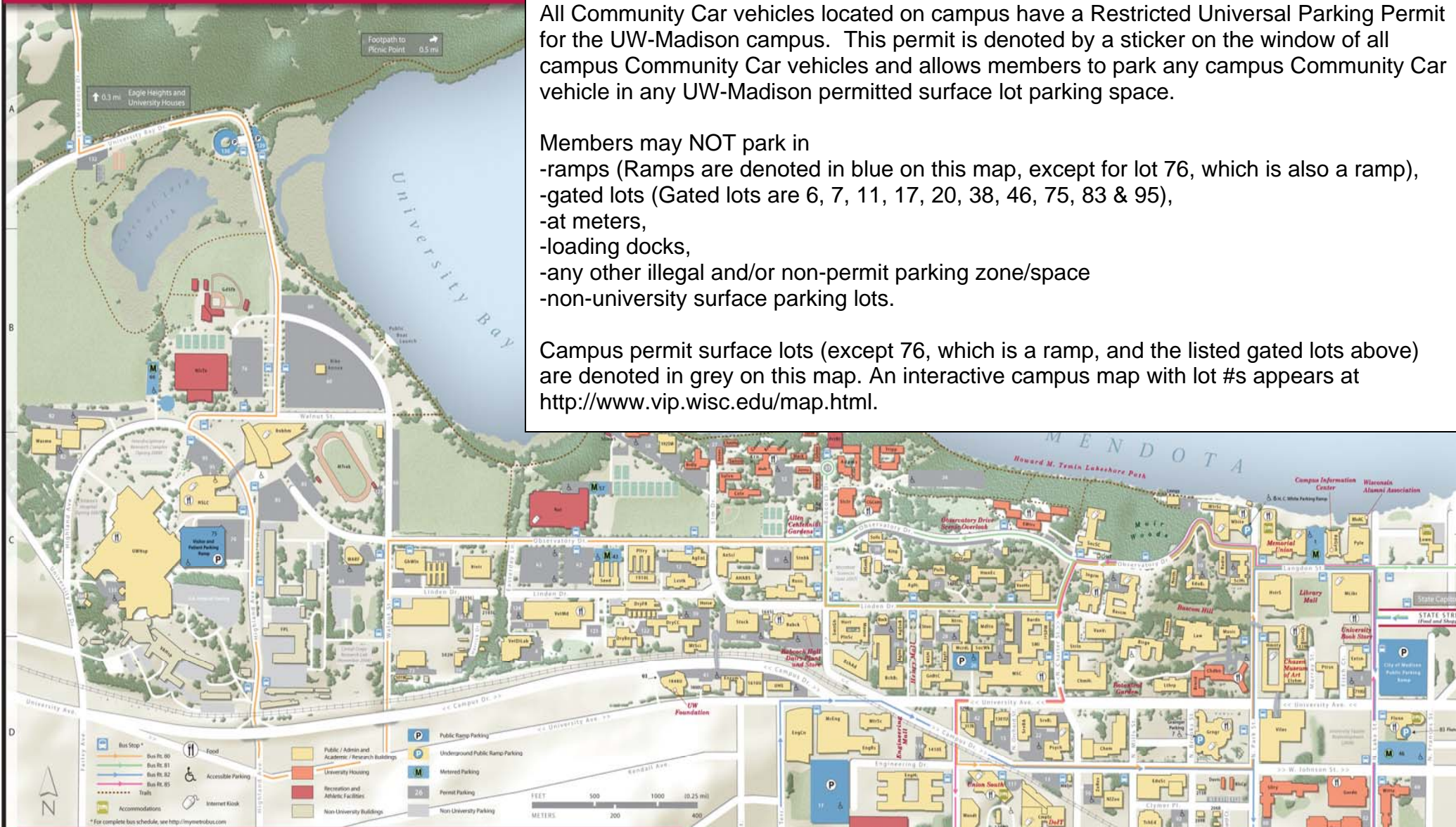




All Community Car vehicles located on campus have a Restricted Universal Parking Permit for the UW-Madison campus. This permit is denoted by a sticker on the window of all campus Community Car vehicles and allows members to park any campus Community Car vehicle in any UW-Madison permitted surface lot parking space.

- Members may NOT park in
- ramps (Ramps are denoted in blue on this map, except for lot 76, which is also a ramp),
  - gated lots (Gated lots are 6, 7, 11, 17, 20, 38, 46, 75, 83 & 95),
  - at meters,
  - loading docks,
  - any other illegal and/or non-permit parking zone/space
  - non-university surface parking lots.
